Mayor Brundige announced they are raising the steel at the library this week. He had a Zoom meeting about the Library and the progress, and they reported 27 rain days for the month of March.

Mayor Brundige commented that we hope to have an ABC meeting soon. We have had our ordinances rewritten. Instead of having multiple ordinances we have combined it all into one.
