**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MARTIN TO PARTICIPATE IN  
The Pool's "Safety Partners" Matching Grant Program**

WHEREAS, the safety and well-being of the employees of the City of Martin is of the greatest importance; and

WHEREAS, all efforts shall be made to provide a safe and hazard-free workplace for the City of Martin employees; and

WHEREAS, The Pool seeks to encourage the establishment of a safe workplace by offering a "Safety Partners" Matching Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Martin now seeks to participate in this important program.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARTIN, TENNESSEE the following:

SECTION 1. That the City of Martin is hereby authorized to submit application for a “*Safety Partners*” *Matching Grant Program* through The Pool.

SECTION 2. That the City of Martin is further authorized to provide a matching sum to serve as a match for any monies provided by this grant.
